Proof of Identification:

- ID NYC
- Benefit Card
- Government issued ID (foreign passport, State ID)

Financially Impacted by COVID-19*

- Unemployment payments
- Decrease in work hours (paystubs, tax returns)
- Excluded Worker Fund payments
- Increase in COVID-19 related expenses (Medical bills, caring for another family member)

Risk of Homelessness*

- Letter from Landlord demanding rent money owed
- Rent Demand Notice from Landlord
- Queens Civil Court Eviction Notice

Proof of Income:

- Pay-stubs during 2019 & 2020
- Tax returns for 2019 & 2020
- Letter from Employer for 2019 & 2020
